

## Privacy policy

### 1. Purpose of data collection

### 3. Duration of the storage of your personal data

We delete data records regularly and quickly when and insofar as the purposes for which the data was collected or processed have ceased to apply and the deletion does not conflict with any statutory retention periods.

### 4. Your rights
